



Bohdy Jaworski Mentorship Award
Sponsored by Fresenius Kabi Canada Ltd.

This award was established in 1995 to recognize the long-term service and achievements of Bohdy Jaworski from the Health Sciences Centre. Bohdy Jaworski has been a member of CSHP for 25 years and served as the Assistant Director of Drug Purchasing and Inventory Control for 38 years at the Health Sciences Centre, until his retirement in 1995.

The purpose of this award is to recognize members who have made significant contributions to the profession of pharmacy through mentorship in hospital or health systems pharmacy practice, outside of the WRHA Pharmacy Residency Program.

Award Description

- The award consists of a cheque in the amount of \$1000 and a framed certificate with the winner's name.
- The award will be presented at the Annual General Meeting of the Branch on an annual basis.

Eligibility

The nominee must be an active member of CSHP MB Branch and have at least three years of experience as a mentor in hospital pharmacy practice. The nominee must be nominated by an active member of the MB Branch whom is a mentee. Nominees are not eligible if they have won the award in the previous award year.

Selection Criteria

- The nominee must be a current member in good standing of the CSHP MB Branch for at least three years.
- The nominee should have at least three years' experience in hospital/health systems pharmacy practice, and may have been involved with the following activities:
 - Precept undergraduate pharmacy students, technicians, and interns
 - Train and/or supervise pharmacist peers in patient care activities, pharmacy research and/or pharmacy administration
- The nominee must exemplify the combined skills of a teacher, a mentor, a recognized leader and practitioner through following activities:
 - Positive influence on pharmacy practice to students, peers, and/or staff
 - Continued upgrading of his/her own skills
 - Teaching through sharing of the nominee's own experiences
 - Ability to motivate and encourage students, peers, and/or staff
 - Readily creates opportunities for students, peers and/or staff to gain valuable experiences
 - Enhances the professional image of a hospital/health systems pharmacist through recognized patient care activities, pharmacy services, research activities, publications, invited presentations, etc.
 - Active participation in various professional committees or membership in relevant associations, with preference given towards involvement with CSHP locally or nationally



Submission Requirements

- One electronic copy of a letter of nomination containing a written summary, not more than 500 words describing the nominee's contributions to teaching and mentoring.
- Completed application form signed by one CSHP member supporting the nomination.
- An electronic copy of the nominee's CV or resume.

Deadline: January 31

Application will be judged solely on the data submitted. An application may be held for 1 award year to act as supplemental material should a candidate be nominated in subsequent years.
