



CSHP Pharmacy Practice Residency Award

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The Pharmacy Practice Residency Award is presented annually to a hospital pharmacy resident whose major project is judged to be the most deserving in terms of significant innovation, practical application and/or development in an institutional pharmacy practice setting.

Award Description

- The award consists of a cheque in the amount of \$1000.
- Each resident shall provide an electronic copy of their residency project manuscript and abstract to the Branch Awards Committee
- Presentation of the Award will be made at CSHP Hot Topics and Residency Awards Reception in November.
- The winner's abstract will be submitted for publication in the Branch Newsletter – PharmaShare. As well, CSHP National will recognize all provincial award recipients in the Canadian Journal of Hospital Pharmacy and at the Awards Luncheon Program at the Professional Practice Conference held annually in Toronto.

Eligibility Criteria

- Be a current Member of CSHP and must have been a Member of CSHP at the time the residency was completed;
- Be currently enrolled in, or one year post-completion, of a CPRB-accredited (or accreditation-pending) pharmacy practice residency program in the province of the branch administering the award.
- Submit an award application to the branch in the province in which the residency was completed. The residency project manuscript must be formatted according to the Canadian Journal of Hospital Pharmacy's (CJHP) Author Guidelines.
- A project may only be submitted once for this award.

Application Deadline

September 1 annually, or as determined by the Awards Committee
